

Review of Petition to Annex 7.3 +/- acres from Brown Township to the city of Hilliard by Thomas F. Kibbey, Esq. Case #ANX-EXP2-16-09 (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & PLANNING)

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Franklin County, State of Ohio, proceeded to journalize the petition that Thomas F. Kibbey, Esq. filed on behalf of the Board of Education of the Hilliard City School District on September 3, 2009 and solicited to and/or been heard by all persons desiring to be reviewed for or against the granting of the Expedited Type 2 petition, and having considered all the facts with reference thereto, being fully advised, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners make the following findings based upon the exhibits and testimony presented at the review of this matter:

- 1. The petition does meet all the requirements set forth in, and was filed in the manner provided in, section 709.021 of the Revised Code.
- 2. The persons who signed the petition are owners of the real estate located in the territory proposed for annexation and constitute all of the owners of real estate in that territory.
- 3. The territory proposed for annexation does not exceed five hundred acres.
- 4. The territory proposed for annexation shares a contiguous boundary with the municipal corporation to which annexation is proposed for a continuous length of at least five percent of the perimeter of the territory proposed for annexation.
- 5. The annexation will not create an unincorporated area of the township that is completely surrounded by the territory proposed for annexation.
- 6. The municipal corporation to which annexation is proposed has agreed to provide to the territory proposed for annexation the services specified in the relevant resolution #09-R-35, passed on September 14, 2009 by the city of Hilliard.



PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF 7.3 ACRES +/-

IN BROWN TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO TO THE CITY OF HILLIARD

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, Township of Brown and lying in Virginia Military Survey Number 6637, being all of the 2.481 acre tract conveyed to Scioto-Darby Local Board of Education by deed of record in Deed Book 2728, Page 404, all of the 2.567 acre tract conveyed to The Board of Education of Brown Rural School District, Franklin County, Ohio by deed of record in Deed Book 970, Page 197 and Deed Book 971, Page 228, and all of the 2.225 acre tract conveyed to The Board of Education of Scioto-Darby Local School District by deed of record in Deed Book 2661, Page 545, (all records of the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio), and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an angle point in the existing City of Hilliard Corporation Line as established by Ordinance Number 09-02 of record in Instrument Number 200903160036425, being the southeasterly corner of an original 119.525 acre tract conveyed to the Board of Education of the Hilliard City School District by deed of record in Instrument Number 200607210143410, a common corner to said 2.225 acre and said 2.481 acre tracts, and a 56.806 acre tract conveyed to Margaret L. Schreck, etal by deed of record in Deed Books 2618, Page 15 and 2967, Page 71, Instrument Numbers 199908020195422, 199909030226776, and 199910010247544;

Thence EASTERLY, a distance of 162 feet, more or less, along a line common to said 56.806 acre and 2.481 acre tracts, to a point at the northeasterly corner of said 2.481 acre tract;

Thence SOUTHERLY, a distance of 780 feet, more or less, along a line common to said 56.806 acre and 2.481 acre tracts, to a point in the northerly right-of-way line of Roberts Road, being 40 feet north of the centerline, and the northeasterly corner of a 0.754 acre tract (Parcel 6-WD) conveyed to Franklin County Commissioners by deed of record in Instrument Number 199708270078876;

Thence WESTERLY, a distance of 411 feet, more or less, along the northerly right-of-way line of said Roberts Road and said 0.754 acre tract (Parcel 6-WD) to a point at the intersection with the easterly right-of-way line of Walker Road, being 40 feet east of the centerline of said Walker Road;

Thence NORTHERLY, a distance of 661 feet, more or less, along the easterly right-of-way line of said Walker Road, a line common to said 0.754 acre tract (Parcel 6-WD) and a 0.373 acre tract (Parcel 5-WD) conveyed to Franklin County Commissioners by deed of record in Instrument Number 199708270078878 to a angle point;

Thence NORTHERLY, a distance of 121 feet, more or less, continuing along the easterly right-of-way line of said Walker Road and said 0.373 acre tract (Parcel 5-WD) to an angle point in the said existing City of Hilliard Corporation Line;

Thence EASTERLY, a distance of 247 feet, more less, along the said existing City of Hilliard Corporation Line to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 7.3 acres more or less, all lying in Brown Township.

> A RESOLUTION INDICATING WHAT SERVICES THE CITY OF HILLIARD WILL PROVIDE TO THE 7.3 ACRES ± LOCATED IN TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, ошо. ANNEXATION TO THE CITY, AND TO PROVIDE FOR BUFFER REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, on September 3, 2009, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.023, the property owner seeking the annexation of 7.3 acres ± of real property in Brown Township. Franklin County, Ohio, contiguous to the City of Hilliard, filed a Petition for Annexation of its property to the City of Hilliard with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", notice of which was duly served upon the City of Hilliard as prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 709.023(C) provides that within twenty days after the date that the petition is filed, the municipal corporation to which annexation is sought shall adopt a Resolution stating what services the municipal corporation will provide to the territory seeking annexation and an approximate date by which it will provide those services; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 709.023(C) also provides that within that same twenty day period, a municipal corporation shall adopt an ordinance or resolution stating that, if the territory is annexed and becomes subject to zoning by the municipal corporation and that if the municipality corporation's zoning permits uses in the annexed territory that the municipal corporation determines are clearly incompatible with the uses permitted under current county or township zoning regulations in the adjacent land remaining in the township from which the territory was annexed, the municipal corporation shall require, in the zoning ordinance permitting the incompatible uses, the owner of the annexed territory to provide a buffer separating the use of the annexed territory and the adjacent land remaining within the township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hilliard, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. In the event that the proposed 7.3 acres ± (the "Property") is annexed to the City of Hilliard, Ohio, the City will provide to the Property the full range of municipal services available to the residents of, and to the property within, the City of Hilliard, including but not limited to police protection, mayor's court, public works and street maintenance, residential refuse collection, planning, building, zoning and engineering services, and parks and recreation, all of which can be provided immediately upon the effective date of the annexation as provided by law. Should it be determined that as a result of the annexation, the boundary line between the township and the City divides or segments a street or highway so as to create a road maintenance problem the City, as a condition of the annexation, shall assume the maintenance of that street or highway or otherwise correct the problem.

SECTION 2. The County Commissioners have previously requested information on the status of water and sewer services to and within suburbs of the City of Columbus. The proposed annexation area is included within the boundaries of the area of the City of Hilliard's Water Service Contract and Sewerage Contract with the City of Columbus and those services are provided in accordance with the terms and conditions of those contracts. The City of Hilliard shall be under no obligation to extend water or sewer lines to any of the Property at the cost of the City or in contravention of the contracts.

SECTION 3. If the Property is annexed and becomes subject to the City of Hilliard zoning and the City zoning permits uses in the annexed territory that the City determines are clearly incompatible with the uses permitted under applicable county or township zoning regulations in effect at the time of the filing of the petition on the land adjacent to the annexed territory remaining in the unincorporated area of Brown Township, then the City of Hilliard will require the owner or owners of the annexed territory to provide a buffer separating the use of the annexed territory and the adjacent land remaining within Brown Township.

SECTION 4. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward and file certified copies of this Resolution with the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners and to send a copy to the Agent for the Petitioners for annexation within twenty days following the date that the petition was filed.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
