- 3. The territory proposed for annexation does not exceed five hundred acres.
- 4. The territory proposed for annexation shares a contiguous boundary with the municipal corporation to which annexation is proposed for a continuous length of at least five percent of the perimeter of the territory proposed for annexation.
- 5. The annexation will not create an unincorporated area of the township that is completely surrounded by the territory proposed for annexation.
- 6. The municipal corporation to which annexation is proposed has agreed to provide to the territory proposed for annexation the services specified in the relevant service ordinance #05-10, passed on October 12, 2010 by the village of Lithopolis.




