



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Reynoldsburg, Ohio hereby states that the following services will be extended to the territory proposed for annexation after annexation. All services listed below will be available and provided upon the date the annexation to the City of Reynoldsburg becomes final:

- A. Water service provided by Water Line Imp. # 463 Waggoner Rd., which has an existing 12" waterline would serve this property.
- B. Sewer service provided by Sanitary Sewer Imp. #447 Waggoner Rd. Area Sanitary Sub Trunk Sewer, which has a 12" sanitary sewer that is 370 feet to the south of the property.
- C. Police protection by Reynoldsburg Division of Police; when emergencies arise, officers will respond within approximately 4 minutes and on average within 15 minutes for non-emergency calls.
- D. Fire protection and emergency medical service will be provided by Truro Township Fire Department, response time to the area would be 4 to 5 minutes.
- E. City of Reynoldsburg Street Department, and Storm Water Utility Department will maintain all public storm sewer systems; maintain all city-owned street lighting; provide snow and ice control per city standard; maintain all public street pavement per city standard; and install and maintain all necessary signs per OMUTCD.
- F. Refuse collection by City franchised private hauler currently Rumpke of Ohio, Inc.

SECTION 2. That this 5.5+/- acre site is annexed and if the City of Reynoldsburg permits uses in the annexed territory that the City of Reynoldsburg determines are clearly incompatible with the uses permitted under current county or township zoning regulations in the adjacent land remaining within Truro Township, the Reynoldsburg City Council will require, in the zoning ordinance permitting the incompatible uses, the owner of the annexed territory to provide a buffer separating the use of the annexed territory and the adjacent land remaining within Truro Township. The term "buffer" stated herein, includes open space, landscaping, fences, walls, and other structured elements: streets and street right-of-way; and bicycle and pedestrian paths and sidewalks.

SECTION 3. That the Clerk of the City of Reynoldsburg file a certified copy of this resolution hereby adopted, to the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County within twenty (20) days of the date the annexation petition is filed.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and health, and further so the resolution can be available for the hearing before the County Commissioners; wherefore upon adoption by Council this resolution shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
