- 5. The annexation will not create an unincorporated area of the township that is completely surrounded by the territory proposed for annexation.
- 6. The municipal corporation to which annexation is proposed has passed Resolution No. CR-25-16 agreeing to provide to the territory proposed for annexation certain services and adopting a statement regarding possible incompatible land uses and zoning buffer. The ordinance was passed by the City of Grove City on May 2, 2016.


