What is a plan?

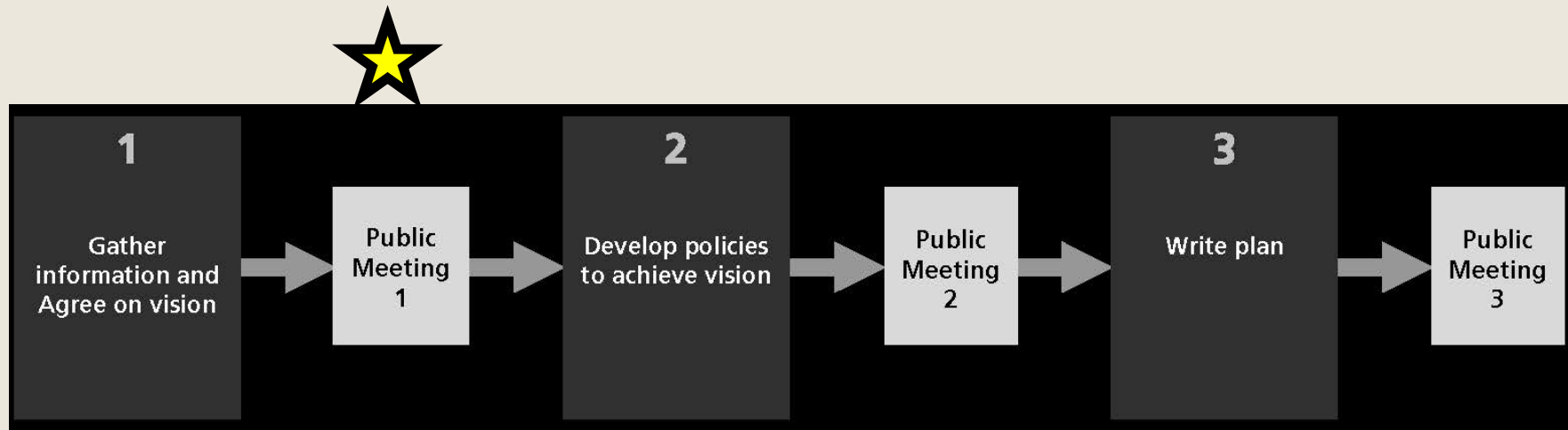
- Vision for a community's future
 - *How land is used* (houses, offices, shops, industries)
 - *What new development looks like*
 - *How people get around* (car, foot, bike, bus)
- Recommendations to achieve the vision
 - *Projects, Programs, and Policies*
 - *Short Term → Long Term*

Why have a plan?

- Community weighs in on the future of the Village
- Gives Predictability
 - *Residents, Land owners, and developers*
 - *Projects & Programs = Your priorities*
- Priorities are communicated with elected and appointed officials

- Anticipate the future

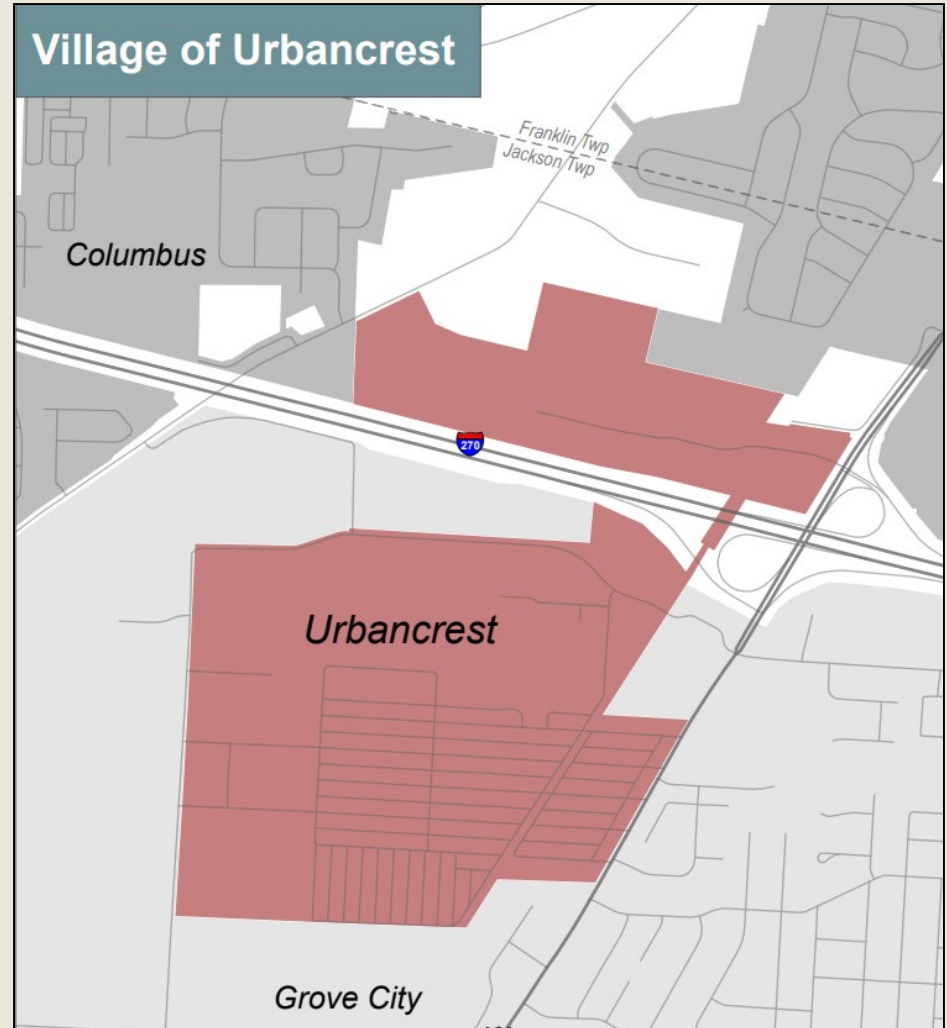
